Should be stacked in one pile, turned parallel to the edge of the street. (\*\*Do not put next to light poles) SMALL BRUSH: Should be bundled and tied with string or twine. Hedge trimmings will be accepted if bundled. No grass clippings accepted.

and ask landscapers and other maintenance companies to not park in blind spots if they must park their vehicles in the street.


### Why shower you wonder?

### If you've ever had red eyes or a runny nose

after your swim, surprise! It's NOT from the chlorine, as people usually believe; it's actually the chemicals mixing with URINE and all the other bodily fluids that people leave behind in a pool, like SWEAT, dirt and POOP! We all have small amounts of fecal matter on our bodies, tiny germs, potentially Cryptosporidium (aka "Crypto"),

E. coli and norovirus germs, which can be released in the water. Swallowing even a small amount of water with fecal matter has the potential to make you and others sick. All of those germs swirling around in the pool are also a likely cause of swimmer's ear. Chlorine takes a while to kill germs so they can be floating around you. IMPORTANT for the reasons above... parents need to insist their

children take bathroom breaks often to pee and have them take showers before swimming. Please remind them to be careful not to swallow the water.

trimmed and maintained by the homeowner. Trees should be kept trimmed at least 9' above side walks/roads/allies to make clear ways for people, bikes and vehicles to travel underneath clearly. The town of Bermuda Run picks up branches the last Monday of the month at your curb for your convenience.

outside Eastbound lane, west of the Yadkin River, beginning on Friday, June 1st at 6:00 PM. It will be reopened no later than Sunday, June 3rd at noon. This work is part of the continuing construction to replace the I-40 bridges over the Yadkin River, and to widen and make improvements along I-40. The project runs from Harper Road in Forsyth County, to 1 mile west of the NC 801 interchange in Davie County. Additional similar weekend lane closures are tentatively scheduled for June 8 thru 10 and June 15 thru 17. Work will progress through the entire project limits.
