Brush & Limb Pick Up (Normally Last Monday of Every Month)

DAY: Monday, October 28, 2019
TIME: 7:00 AM
WHERE: Street Curb Of Residency
LIMBS: Should be reasonably fresh and solid (no stacks of rotten wood). Should be no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 12 feet. Should be stacked in one pile, turned parallel to the edge of the street. (**Do not put next to light poles) **SMALL BRUSH:** Should be bundled and tied with string or twine. Hedge trimmings will be accepted if bundled. No grass clippings accepted.

SAFETY ALERTS

ALERT MUD BOG (Quicksand like mud)

ALERT SKATEBOARDERS

Skateboarding is a wonderful outdoor physical activity. To keep everyone safe, both skateboarders and vehicles should follow road safety. Young adults may need reminders.



ROAD SAFETY KINDERTON COMMUNITY

- VEHICLES:**
- Stop at stop signs
 - Speed limits are 25 in the community
 - Watch for children at play



SKATEBOARDERS: (Parents talk to your children about these skateboarding tips that could save their lives or from injury. There have been reports of a couple skateboarders that could benefit from knowing these safety tips.)

- Obey traffic rules
- Stop at stop signs and look both ways
- Do not skateboard in the middle of the road
- Do not ride through intersection on roads with no stop signs
- Ride on the far left side of the road facing traffic so you can see on coming vehicles and move off the roadway.
- Never grab the bumper of a vehicle or school bus. Vehicles could stop unexpectedly and the skate boarder could receive major injuries. (Someone witnessed a skateboarder grab a bus bumper to hitch a ride.)
- Where a helmet

Did you know there is a skate park in Winston-Salem called Fairground Skate Park? Park is located next to the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex, across from the Wake Forest Baseball Park.
