LIMBS: Should be reasonably fresh and solid (no stacks of rotten wood). Should be no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 12 feet. Should be stacked in one pile, turned parallel to the edge of the street. (**Do not put next to light poles) SMALL BRUSH: Should be bundled and tied with string or twine. Hedge trimmings will be accepted if bundled. No grass clippings accepted. Try to put limbs closer to pick up day to not kill grass

Trees are picked up at street curb of residency. NOT IN THE STREET (Reminder remove all decorations, stands, nails and plastic bags.)





Choose a color that contrasts with the surface area that you choose to hang them. Reflective numbers or lighting near the number will increases their visibility also.
